- Never carry out any alterations or modifications to this product.
- Suitable for multiple types of small birds.
- This product is not a toy, and is only to be used for its designated purpose.
- This product is intended for indoor use.
- Keep fingers, loose clothing, and hair away when assembling the product.
- Make sure all fastenings are tightly in place and that everything is in order before using the product. This should be checked periodically by an adult.
- This product contains small parts that could be a choking hazard if swallowed. Keep these items away from children.
- If a pet is inside of the product, sure that the entrance panels are secured into place by the entrance latches before leaving the product on its own.
- Leaving the product outside exposed to weather, especially direct sun, rain and salt air, will speed the weathering process. This can be slowed by removing the product from these conditions or covering it with a suitable cover.
- Clean only with a damp cloth. Do not use strong industrial cleaning substances or abrasive materials as these will damage the product.
- Do not discard any of the packaging until you have checked that you have all of the parts and fittings required.
- Use the correct fixings as indicated. Do not tighten any of the nuts until the unit is completely assembled, then finish by tightening all nuts. All nuts must be tightened before use.

Operating Instructions

Please be aware that you will be referring to this parts list throughout the assembly process.

- a. Upper part of the cage [1]
- b. Lower part of the cage [1]
- c. Top Net [1]
- d. Top rings [1]
- e. Perches [3]
- f. Feeding Bowls [4]
- g. Plastic Tray [1]
- h. Plastic Base [1]
- 1. Make up parts (a) and (b).
- 2. Piece parts (a) and (b) together using the hooks.
- 3. Place part (c) on the top of the previously constructed sections.
- 4. Separate parts (f) into two parts and combine parts together to create feeding bowls (*see figure 1*).
- 5. Put the feeding bowls in the small doors on the main frame and close the door.
- 6. Attach part (d) to the top of the cage.
- 7. Place part (e) into the cage.
- 8. Place part (g) and (h) inside the cage at the bottom *(see figure 2),* and push part (g) into part (h).
