Safety Instructions

- 3. Avoid touching mobile parts of the fan.
- 4. Make sure the fan is on a dry and even surface.
- Never insert fingers, pencils or any other objects through the guards whenever the power plug is connected, especially while running.
- The appliance is not intended for use by young children or infirm persons unless they have been adequately supervised by a responsible person to ensure that they can use the appliance safely.

- 7. This is not a toy. Do not play with the fan.
- Do not use the appliance for any other purpose than its intended use.
- The fan must not be used if the guards are not fastened according to instructions.
- When the power cord is damaged, it must be replaced by a qualified person in order to avoid a hazard.
- Do not use your appliance with an extension cord unless it has been checked and tested by a qualified electrician or electrical supplier.

Keep instructions for future reference.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Always disconnect the cord from the electrical outlet when cleaning your fan.
- Light accumulated dust may be removed from the fan with a soft cloth or vacuum cleaner using the dusting brush attachment.
- 3. Wipe the exterior surfaces of the fan occasionally with a cloth
- moistened(not dripping wet)with a mild soap solution. Dry the case thoroughly with a soft dry cloth before operating the fan.
- Avoid the use of gasoline, benzene, thinner etc as they may result in damage to the fan.
- 5. Store the fan in a clean dry place when not in use.

- Read all instructions before using the fan.

- UNPLUG OR DISCONNECT THIS FAN FROM THE POWER SUPPLY BEFORE SERVICING.



Operating Instructions

Please be aware that you will be referring to this parts list throughout the assembly process.



- Remove all items of packaging from the fan.
- 2. Remove the locking nut from the motor shaft.
- Position the rear guard over the motor shaft, ensuring that the notches are correctly aligned and then secure with the locking nut.

Fan Direction Adjustment

- Do not attempt to make any adjustment to the direction of the grille and fan assembly until the fan has been turned off and unplugged from the socket.
- To adjust the direction of the fan, hold the grille and gently tilt the fan until the desired position is reached.
- Plug the fan back into the socket and turn the fan on.

- Align the fan blade with the flat part on the motor shaft and secure by tightening the blade cap by turning counter-clockwise.
- Attach the front guard centre to the middle of the rear guard and secure by pushing the guards together until they click into position.
- Tighten the locking screw.

Operating Instructions

- 1. Use in a dry place, free of excessive humidity and water.
- To set the fan in motion simply pull the control string until you reach the desired speed. The speed selected will be display on the rotary speed indicator

- 3. Pull the oscillating control string once to make the fan oscillate.
- 4. Pull the string again to stop the fan oscillating.
