- To clean the circular hot plate can be removed with household cleaning powder. Wait to cool down before cleaning.

Operating Instructions

How to use your Hot Plate:

Before using your hot plate for the first time, turn the hot plate on the highest setting for 3-5 minutes to condition the protective coating.

For the most efficient operation of your 1.5kW hot plate, the cooking utensils used should have a solid base with a diameter of approx. 18-20cm and a maximum of 1.5L. For your double 2.5Kw (1.5kW & 1kW) hot plate, diameter of the smaller plate of approx. 15-17cm.

Turn the controls to the recommended position marked to achieve the desired temperature:

- 1. For simmering of delicate foods and thickening sauces
- 2. Slow cooking
- 3. For simmering large quantities
- 4. To bring all dishes to rapid heat
- 5. Bring to a Boil

Note: the light will go off when the hot plate reaches the selected temperature, and will cycle on and off to maintain the temperature.
