- To prevent potential injury, never overreach whilst using this ladder.

- Warning! Do not overreach whilst using this ladder.
- Warning! Do not ascend or descend unless you are facing the ladder.
- Warning! Be sure to carry out a risk assessment of the surrounding working area. Check for overhead electrical cables, the floor surface and the surrounding space.
- Warning! Avoid work that imposes a sideways load on the ladder, such as side-on drilling through solid materials.
- Warning! Do not use this ladder as a bridge.
- Warning! Do not step off the side of standing ladder onto another surface.

- Keep fingers and loose clothing, jewellery and hair away whilst folding or unfolding this product.
- Only use this ladder on stable, level and dry ground.
- Keep your body centred when using this ladder.
- Leaving the product outside exposed to weather, especially direct sun and rain, will speed the weathering process. To slow the weathering process down, remove the product from these conditions.
- Warning! Do not exceed the maximum capacity of 150kg.
- Warning! Keep a secure grip whilst ascending or descending the ladder.
- Warning! Inspect the ladder after delivery. Before every use, check for damage or defects. If damaged or defective, never use this ladder.
- Warning! A maximum of 1 user can use this ladder at a time.
- Warning! Do not wear unsuitable footwear when climbing a ladder.

Operating Instructions

The below information is designed to help you with the operation of your Oypla product

If the product is damaged, defective or you require more information, please contact our dedicated team at cservice@oypla.com.

Open the ladder, ensuring that the spreaders lock so that the step ladder is secure.

Place the step ladder on a flat, balanced surface so it can be used in the safest way possible.

When ascending the step ladder, climb only on the silver treads on the front. Do not climb the ladder using the bracing on the back section of

Once you have finished using the step ladder, simply unlock the spreaders and fold the ladder together.



Warning, fall from the ladder.



Keep a secure grip on the ladder when ascending and descending. Maintain a handhold whilst working from a ladder or take additional safety precautions if you cannot.

Avoid work that imposes a sideways load on ladders, such as side-on drilling through solid materials



Inspect the ladder after delivery. Before every use visually check the ladder is not damaged and is safe to use. Do not use a damaged ladder.
