


Assembly should be done by a responsible adult before giving toy to child.





2. Attach a connector to the ends of the

small poles (See picture to the right)





3. Now attach the large poles to the already assembled parts so that the poles are upright (See picture to the left).



4. Attach the target by sliding the brackets on the back of the target onto the stand that has been made. Push the target down the poles until both are in the end bracket and secure (See picture to the right).
