Do not allow the heater to operate for extensive periods of time. Always keep the heater supervised.




Never cover the tubular heater.

Please be aware that you will be referring to this parts list throughout the assembly process.

Holder	2pcs	Tube	1pc
Screw	4pcs	Cable	1pc
Screw Holder	4pcs	BS Plug	1pc

The fixing bracket should be mounted according to the heater length, at a distance to adequately support the tubular heater.

Screw the two bottom halves of the bracket to the wall, place the tubular heater on brackets, and then fasten top brackets over the tub.

Before connecting the heater, check that the supply voltage is the same as that is stated on the rating label.
