- Only use the product on stable, level and dry ground.
- When moving the product be sure that the path is clear of obstacles to avoid damaging the product or causing personal injury.
- Do not stand on any of the shelves if you can't reach an item. This will damage the product and risks breaking the shelf being stood on.
- Before using the product, make sure all fastenings are tightly in place and that everything is in order, and checked periodically by an adult.
- Leaving the product outside exposed to weather, especially direct sun, rain and salt air, will speed the weathering process. This can be slowed by removing the product from these conditions, or covering it with a suitable cover.
- Clean only with a damp cloth. Do not use strong industrial cleaning substances or abrasive materials as these will damage the product.


### **Assembly Instructions**

Please be aware that you will be referring to this parts list throughout the assembly process.





### **Parts**

- 1. Foot x 4
- 2. Pole x 8
- 3. Pole holder x 16
- 4. Wheel x 4
- 5. Shelf x 4



1. To begin, take one wheel and one pole and screw the wheel into pole. Ensure that the wheel is secured correctly by tightening it into place using the spanner. Repeat this step an additional three times.



- 2. If you wish for the product to remain completely still whilst it is in use or to the side, install the feet to the base poles as is done with the wheels in the step above.
- 3. Hold the pole still and place another pole on top, clipping a pole holder onto the joining section of the poles. Ensure that the pole holder is the correct way up (this can be seen by the direction of the arrow, as well as the word "TOP").
- 4. Push a shelf down the pole and onto the pole holder, ensuring that it goes as far down as possible). Once this is done, repeat this step and the step above to continue and complete building the product. Check that all of the shelves are securely held in place before placing any items on them.
