




1) Slide two Long poles (1) through the Shelf (4), then repeat on the other shelf. Next take 2 short poles (2) and attach 4 (Bs) as shown in the photos. Lastly, take another 2 short poles (2) and attach all 4 (As) in the same way as before.

2) Now, attach both shelves (4) to the 4 short poles (2) from step 1 as can be seen in the picture to the right. Ensure each corner can have more poles attached to it in later steps which is also shown in the picture.






3) Join 4 **short poles (2)** to 4 **long poles (1)** using 4 **(Cs)** as shown in the picture. Then, attach these to the **shelves (4)** made in step 2. The **(A)** shelf should be at the bottom with its longest side acting as the legs. See picture.












4) Attach 4 more **short poles (2)** to the remaining 4 **(Bs)** and then attach to the top of the built shelving unit as shown.

5) Next, secure the final 2 short poles (2) and final 2 long poles (1) to the frame.Additionally, add the support pole (3) across the middle lengthways at the top of the frame.







6) The final step, is to now place the **cover (5)** over the assembled frame.
