- Leaving the product outside exposed to weather, especially direct sun, rain and salt air, will speed the weathering process. This can be slowed by removing the product from these conditions, or covering it with a suitable cover.
- Clean only with a damp cloth. Do not use strong industrial cleaning substances or abrasive materials as these will damage the product.

Parts List

Wellington boot holder x 1

Stand x 1

Bolt x 4

Lock nut x 4

Assembly Instructions

1. Unscrew the screws pre-attached to the Wellington boot holder. Once done, align the holes in the Wellington boot holder with the holes in the stand. Ensure that the stand is on the outside of the Wellington boot holder. Once done, screw one of the bolts into the stand and the base of the Wellington boot holder (as seen in the image below).



2. Push a bolt through the other hole, ensuring it goes all the way through. Secure this into place using a lock nut (please see the image below). Make sure the lock nut has been secured correctly, as to avoid it becoming loose in the immediate future. After this, repeat these previous steps on the opposite side to complete the Wellington boot rack.
