



Feet cap – Part A	X4
Legs – Part B	X4
Leg support – Part C	X1
Large Pole – Part D	X1
Small Pole – Part E	X1
Pole Connector – Part F	X1
Top Cap – Part G	X1
3 Arm Hanger – Part H	X1
8 Upper arm – Part I	X1
Pegs – Part J	X24



- To start, attach part A to one end of part B. Repeat this step for all of the legs and feet caps (A and B).
- 2) Then secure the other end of a leg (B) into the leg support (C). Ensure legs are securely fastened and repeat with the remaining legs. Some force/firm pressure may be required to do this step.
- 3) Next, attach the large pole (D) into the leg support (C) as seen on the diagram on the previous page.
- 4) Attach the pole connector (F) onto the top of the large pole (D) before sliding the 3-arm hanger (H) onto the connector. As seen on diagram.
- 5) Now, attach the small pole (E) onto the pole connector (F). Ensure securely fastened.
- 6) Lastly, attach the top cap (G) on top of the small pole (E). To finish assembly place the upper arm (I) on the top of the top cap (G)

Attach desired amount of pegs (J) to the hooks on the upper arm (I). There are 8 arms and each can hold 4 pegs (24 total)!
