

- Only use fuel made for tiki torches. Never use gasoline, ethylated spirits or other flammable liquids.
- Always allow the torches sufficient time to cool down before moving them.

Operating Instructions



Place the lamp on a stable, flat and heatresistant surface. Fill the lamp with lamp oil to a maximum of 1.5cm below the edge of the oil reservoir. Make sure that the wick does not stick out of the wick guard. Let the wick soak the fuel for up to 5-7 minutes before lighting. Light the wick using a lighter or a match. Extinguish the flame by covering the flame completely. Make sure the lamp has cooled down completely before storing. The wick length should be between 0.6cm and 1.25cm in order to prevent smoke and soot. Cut the wick at the desired length. Make the wick longer by pulling.

Only use natural lamp or torch oil that does not cause lung damage after swallowing. Check the label on the bottle of the oil. Only use clear colourless torch oil or lamp oil.

To (re)fill the oil reservoir, first push the wick guard in and open the oil reservoir by turning counter-clockwise. Fill to a maximum of 1.5cm below the edge. Close the oil reservoir carefully by pushing the wick guard and turn clockwise to tighten.

To keep the oil lamp in good condition, store it indoors after use. Make sure it does not get wet or damaged due to weather conditions. Clean the oil lamp with a damp cloth and to protect it, make sure the wick and container stay oily.
