 - Ensure to use the wheel locks to prevent the trolley from moving by itself.
 - Only use this trolley on dry, stable and level ground.
 - This product is not suitable for children.
 - Leaving the trolley exposed to the elements will speed up the weathering process. To prevent this, remove the trolley from these conditions. To prolong the life of the trolley, ensure the working environment is dry and that there is no moisture or dampness.

Assembly Instructions

Please refer to the below information to help assemble your Oypla product

- 1) Start with the bottom tray – attach a corner pole to each corner of the tray, securing each into place with 4 M6x10mm bolt/nut sets.
 - 2) Do the same with the middle tray – again, attach it to the corner poles using 4 M6x10mm bolt/nut sets for each corner. *TIP: laying the trolley on its side while you attach the trays may help if assembling alone.*
 - 3) Use the same method to attach the top tray – make sure to attach the handle by securing it into place with the two larger bolts.
 - 4) Lastly, attach the four wheels using more of the M6x10mm bolt/nut sets. Ensure that the two lockable wheels are in alternating corners for maximum stability whilst locked.
